



STUF United Fund is accepting applications for 2015 ILF (International Leadership Foundation) Programs

STUF United Fund (STUF) is pleased to announce that application process is now open for the following three programs sponsored by STUF and organized by International Leadership Foundation (ILF):

1. **2015 Civic Fellowship Program** for one undergraduate student with US Citizenship
2. **2015 Young Ambassador Program** for one undergraduate or graduate student from Taiwan or oversea Taiwanese communities around the world except for USA
3. **Internship opportunity** for one TJCCNA or WTCC-JC member at ILF Office in Washington D.C.

1. **2015 Civic Fellowship Program:**

Every summer, ILF offers approximately 30 outstanding Asian Pacific American students 8 to 10 weeks interning at a federal agency in Washington D.C. Civic Fellowship candidates will work with federal agencies and limited placements in congressional offices and the White House.

Students who accept the fellowship will receive a stipend of \$2,000, attend weekly leadership seminars on Capitol Hill and gain valuable, firsthand working knowledge of the American government system. Fellows are responsible for their own travel, housing and living expenses.

Undergraduate students of Asian American and Pacific Islander heritage who are United States citizens and possess a GPA of 3.0 and above are eligible for this fellowship. To be selected as the STUF-endorsed participant, applicants need to first **contact Yi-Miao Huang, Executive Director of STUF via info@stufunited.org, and then submit all required documents by February 18th, 2015.**



2. 2015 Young Ambassador Program

STUF will also recommend a student from Taiwan or oversea Taiwanese communities around the world except for USA to join the ILF Young Ambassadors Program. It is a unique 12 day program in summer in Washington D.C. and the Northeast Region including an exciting series of lectures, excursions and discussions on topics ranging from international business relations to public policy and the legislative process. Excursions include visits to the White House, U.S. Congress, federal agencies, United Nations, New York Financial District, and top U.S. universities.

Undergraduate or graduate students who are studying in Taiwan or are Taiwanese decedents in other countries are qualified to apply. USA Citizens are not qualified for this program.
